- Champions of causes identified.
- Volunteers from local churches mobilised.
- Other local churches rallied.
- Intervention develops through local ownership, organic growth and networking.

SAHAARA CHARITABLE SOCIETY

- Seed intervention with one group of slum children scaled up to include:
 - Trafficked Women and Their Children
 - Children in Remand Homes
 - Men, Women and Children In Prisons
 - Children in Slums
 - Visually Challenged & Their Children
 - Home for Destitute Children (Boys)
 - Lepers, Drug Addicts & Street Children
